SELF-REPORTING OF DISQUALIFYING OFFENSES BY NON- INSTRUCTIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYEES AND CONTRACTORS

Per Florida Statute 1012.465

- (1) Each non-instructional school district employee or contractor shall agree to inform his or her employer or the party to whom he or she is under contract and the school district within 48 hours if he or she is arrested for any of the following disqualifying offenses:
- Any offense that would require registration as a sexual offender;
 - Sexual misconduct with certain developmentally disabled clients and reporting thereof;
 - Terrorism;
 - Murder;
 - Kidnapping;
 - Lewdness and indecent exposure;
 - Incest; and
 - Child abuse, aggravated child abuse, or neglect of a child.
- (2) A contractor who willfully fails to comply with this subsection commits a felony of the third degree. If the employer of a contractor or the party to whom the contractor is under contract knows the contractor has been arrested for any of the disqualifying offenses listed above and authorizes the contractor to be present on school grounds when students are present, such employer or such party commits a felony of the third degree.

SIGNATURE BLOCK:
