MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- ✓ Master's degree or higher from an accredited educational institute.
- ✓ Eligible for certificate which designates Educational Leadership, Administration, and/or Administration/Supervision certification.
- ✓ Three (3) years of successful experience as a classroom teacher.

ENTRY QUALIFICATION - If minimum qualifications are met, applicants may enter the Administrative Pipeline through one of the options listed below:

1. State certification as a School Principal or the equivalent thereof **OR**
2. Three years of successful administrative experience, resulting in an overall effective or highly effective evaluation or the equivalent thereof **OR**
3. Consensus scores of three or higher on Targeted Selection Interview and Essay exercises.
