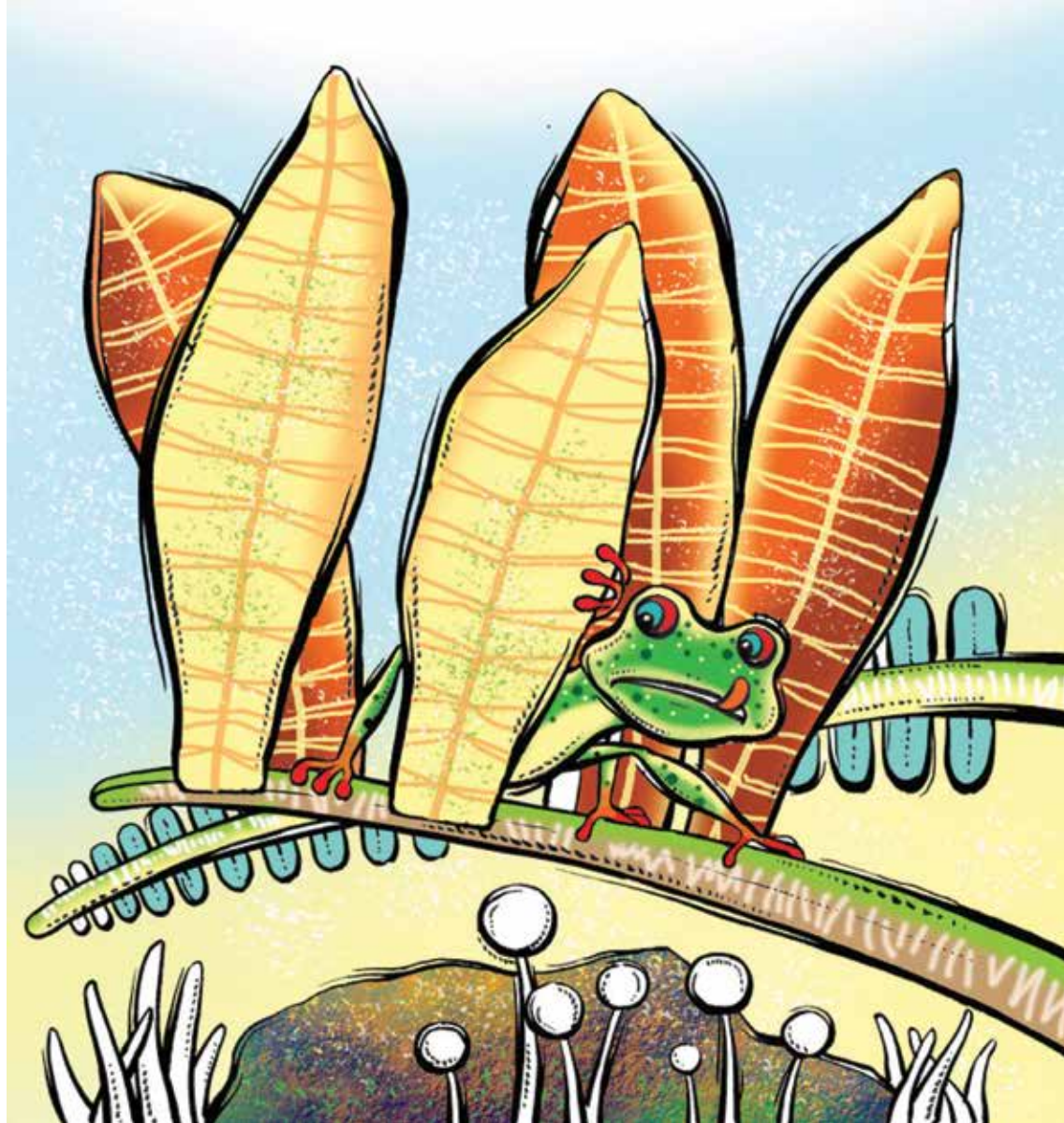

“I wish I had food today,” he said.



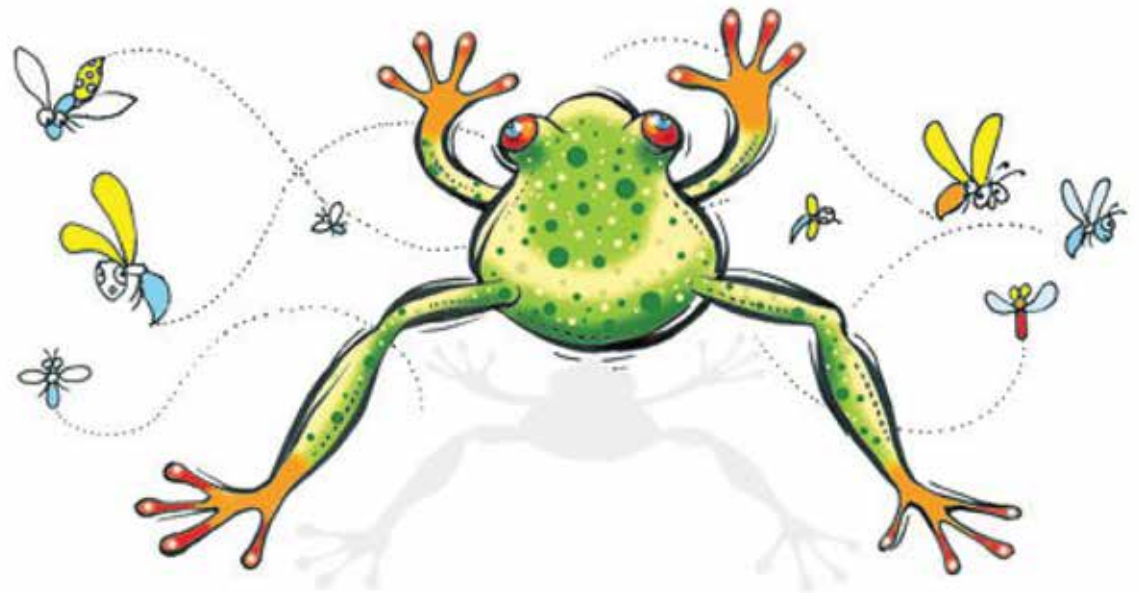
“I wish I could eat those bugs!” he said.

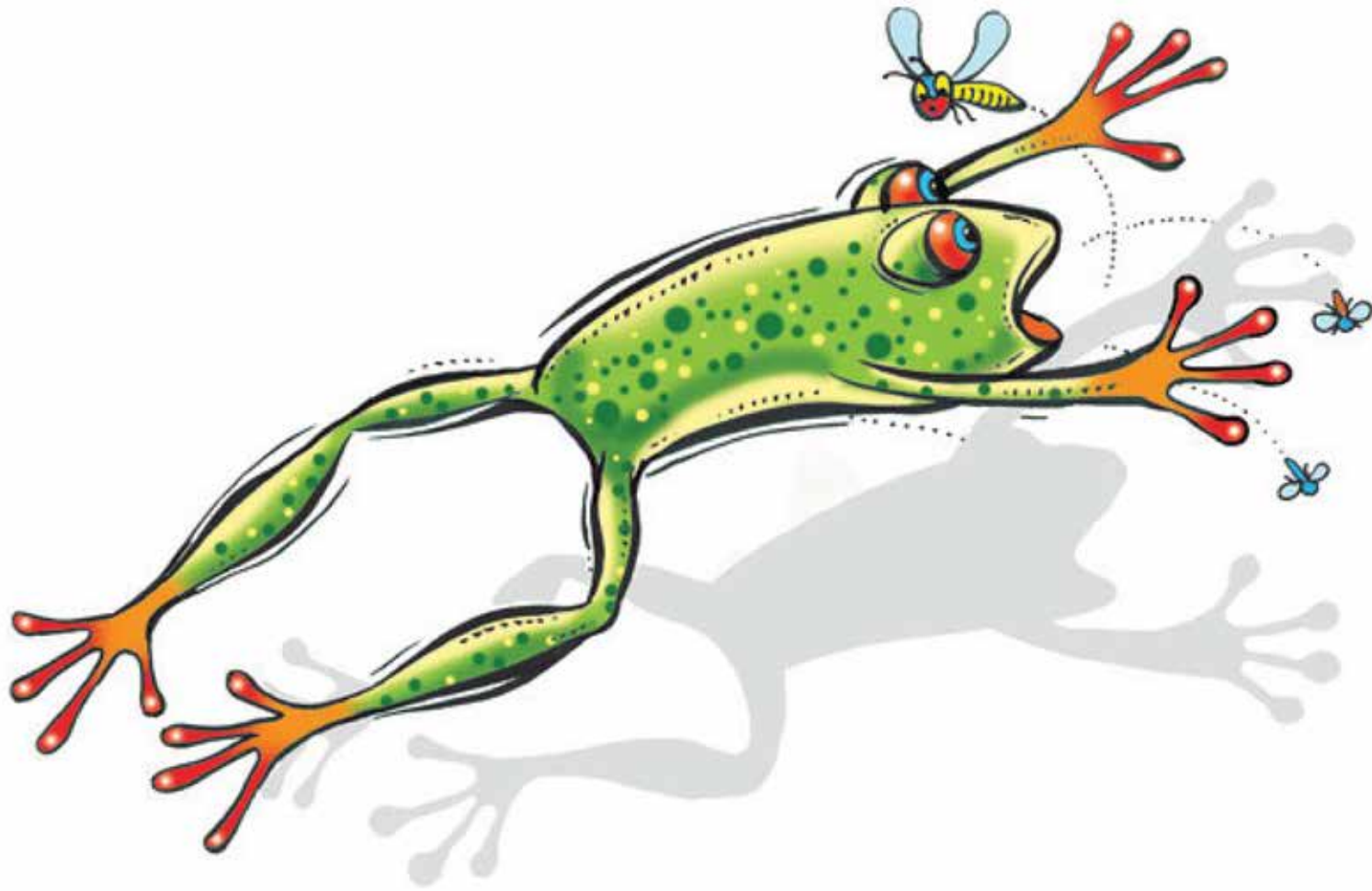


“I need to catch those bugs,”



said Frog.



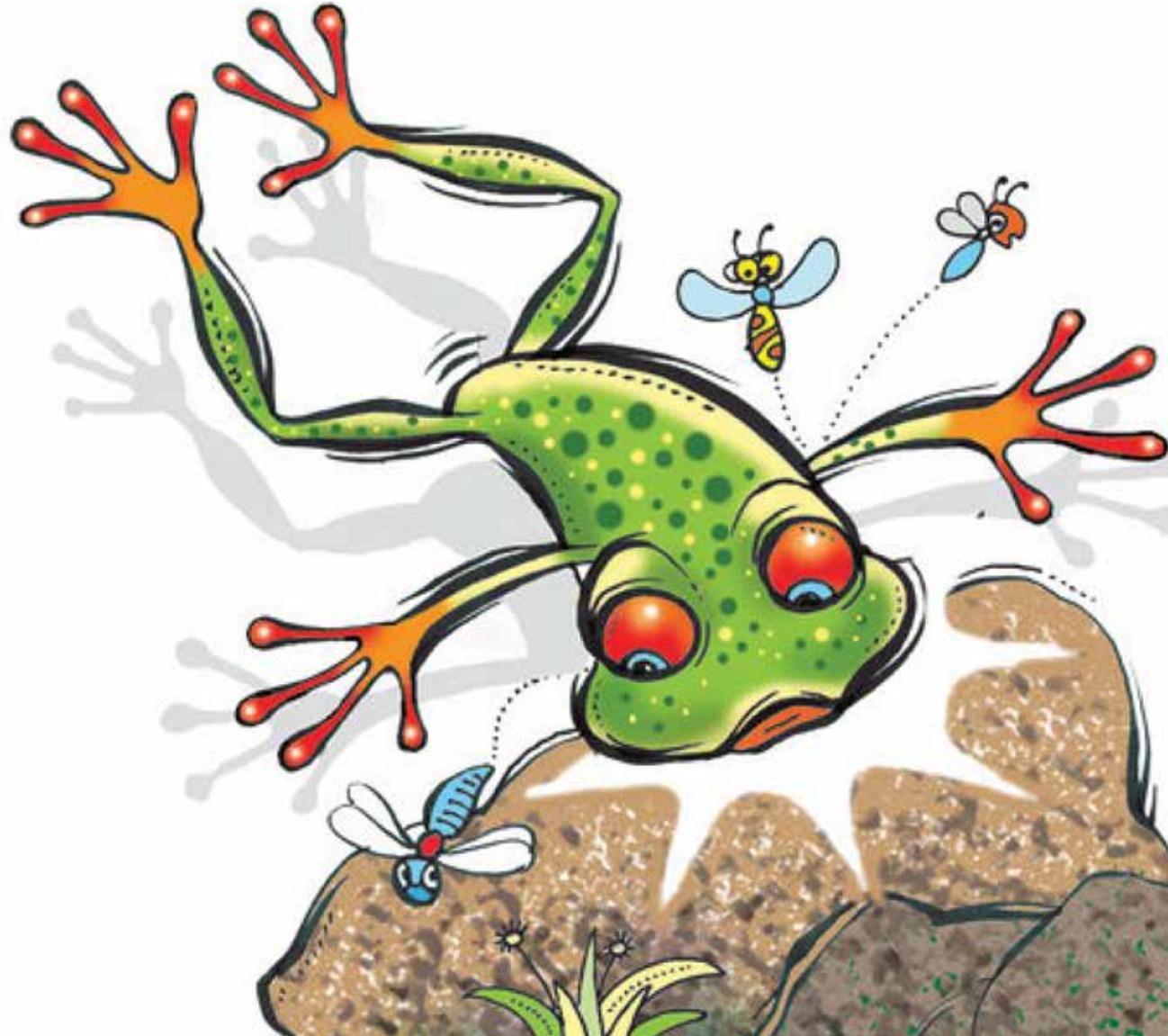


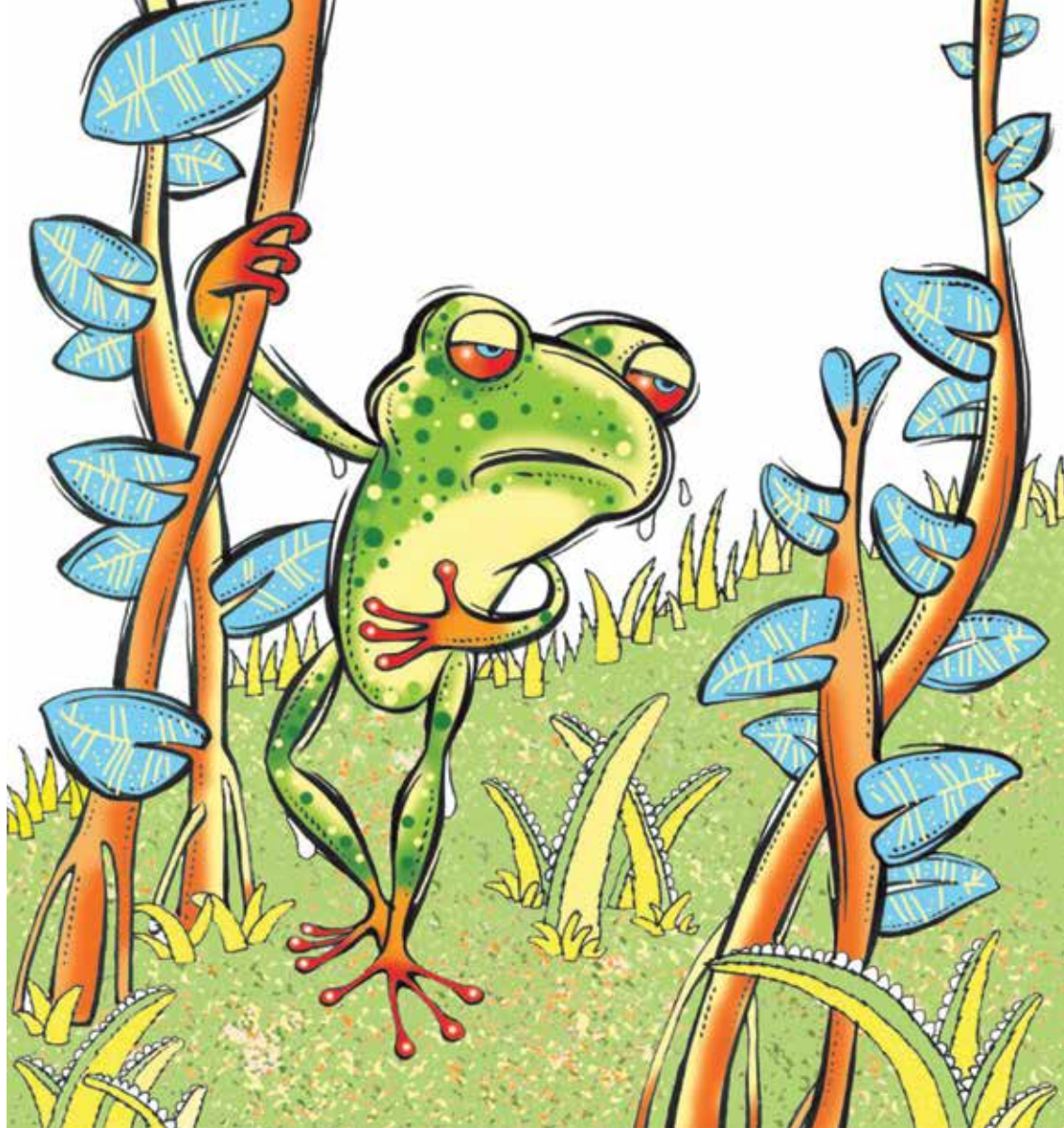
The bugs were too far away.

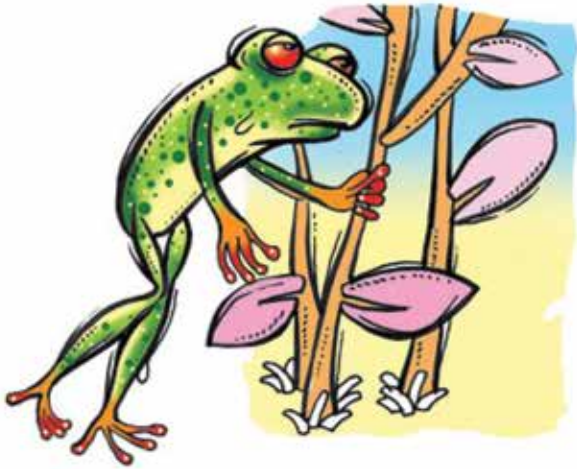


He could not catch any bugs today!

“How will I catch the bugs?” he asked.

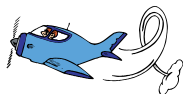




Then he saw a light shining far away.
