He was hungry!

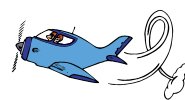


“I wish I had food today,” he said.



He went to find food.

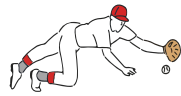




He saw a lot of bugs flying around.



“I wish I could eat those bugs!” he said.

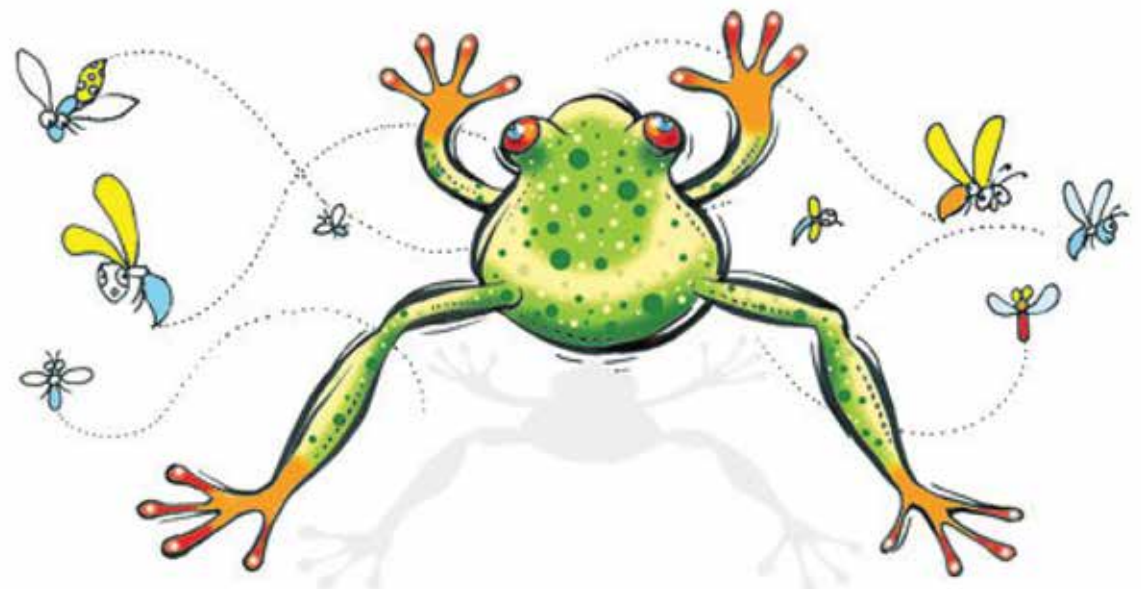


“I need to catch those bugs,” said Frog.

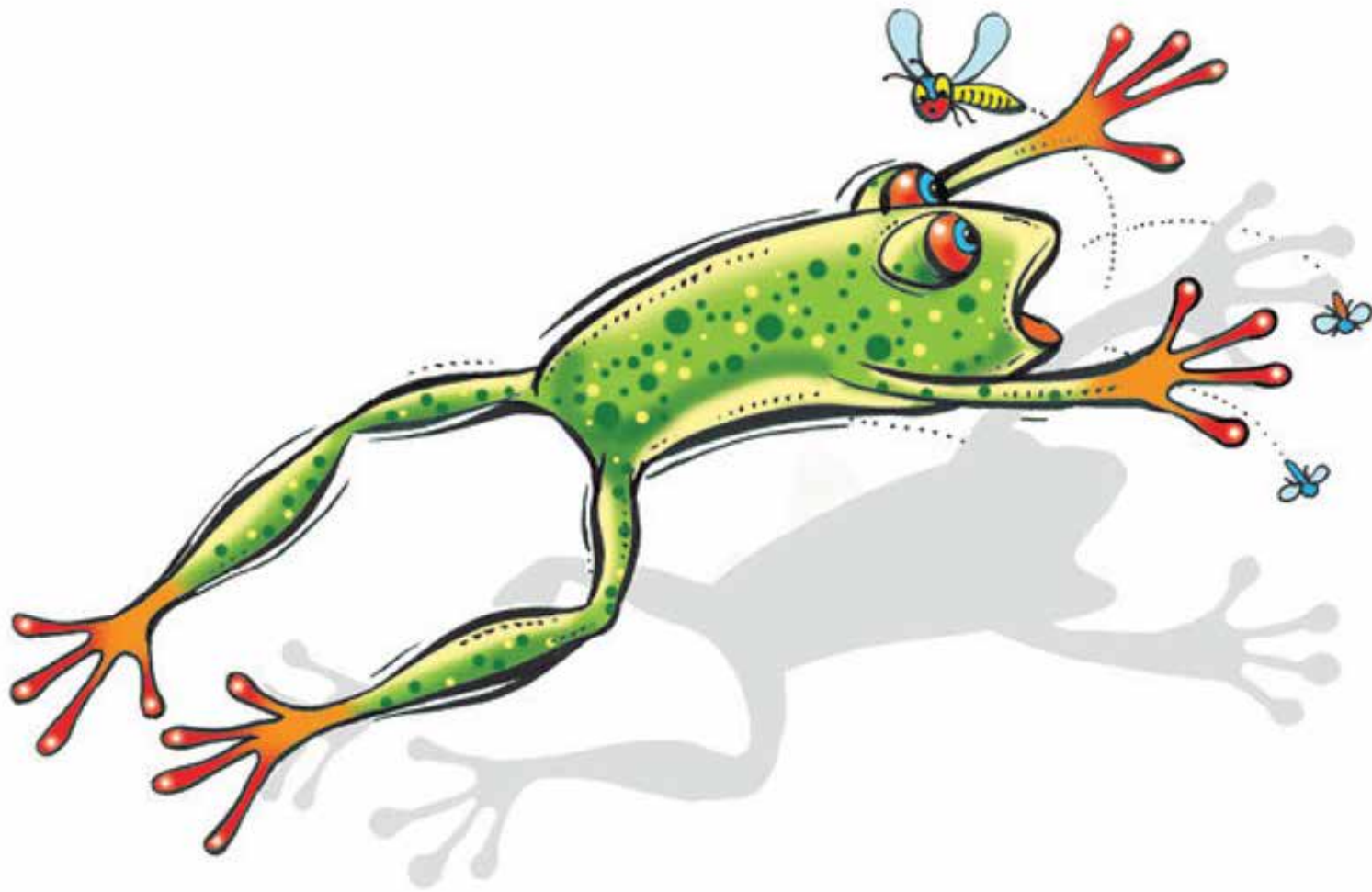


Frog jumped here

The bugs were too far away.

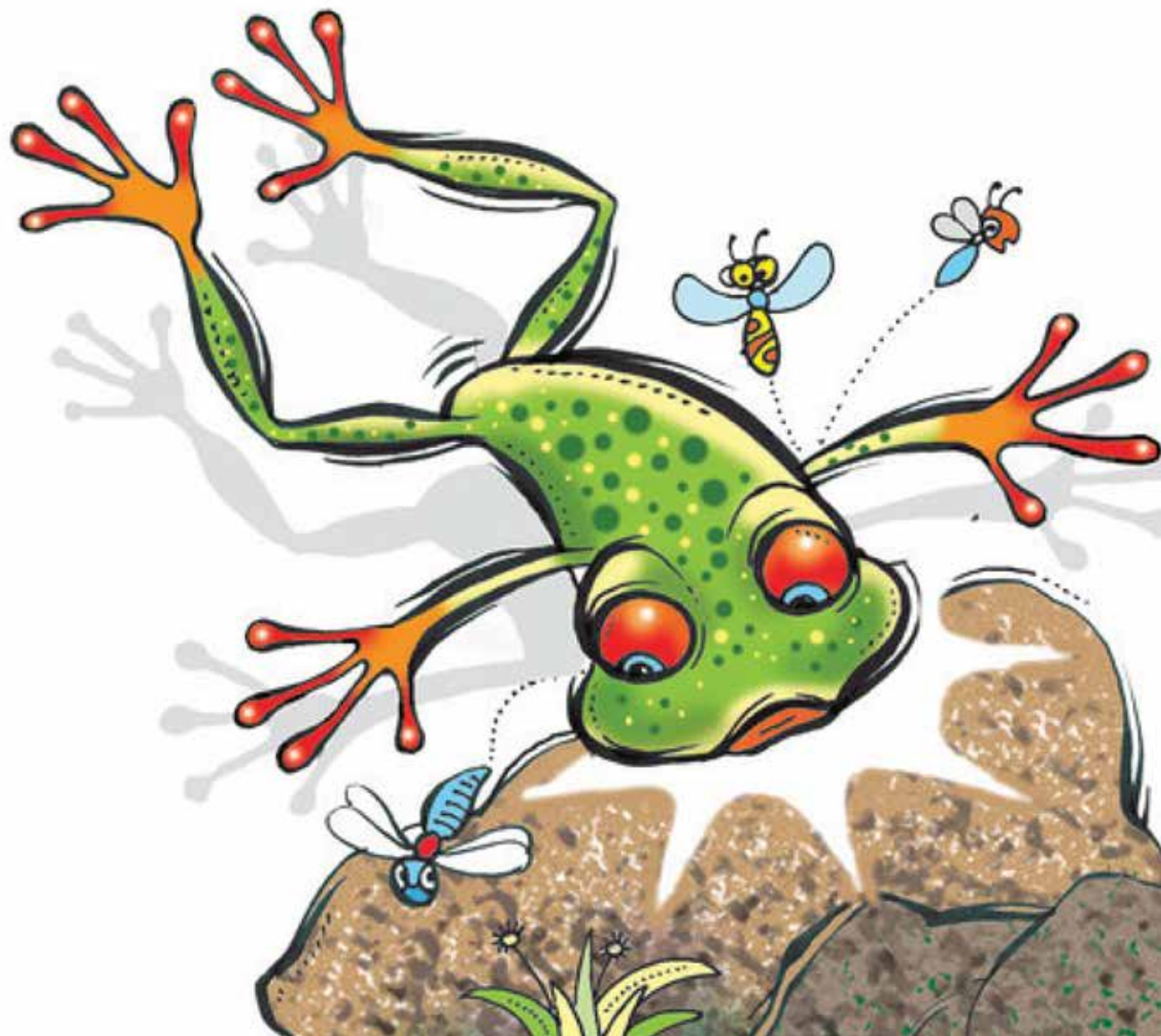


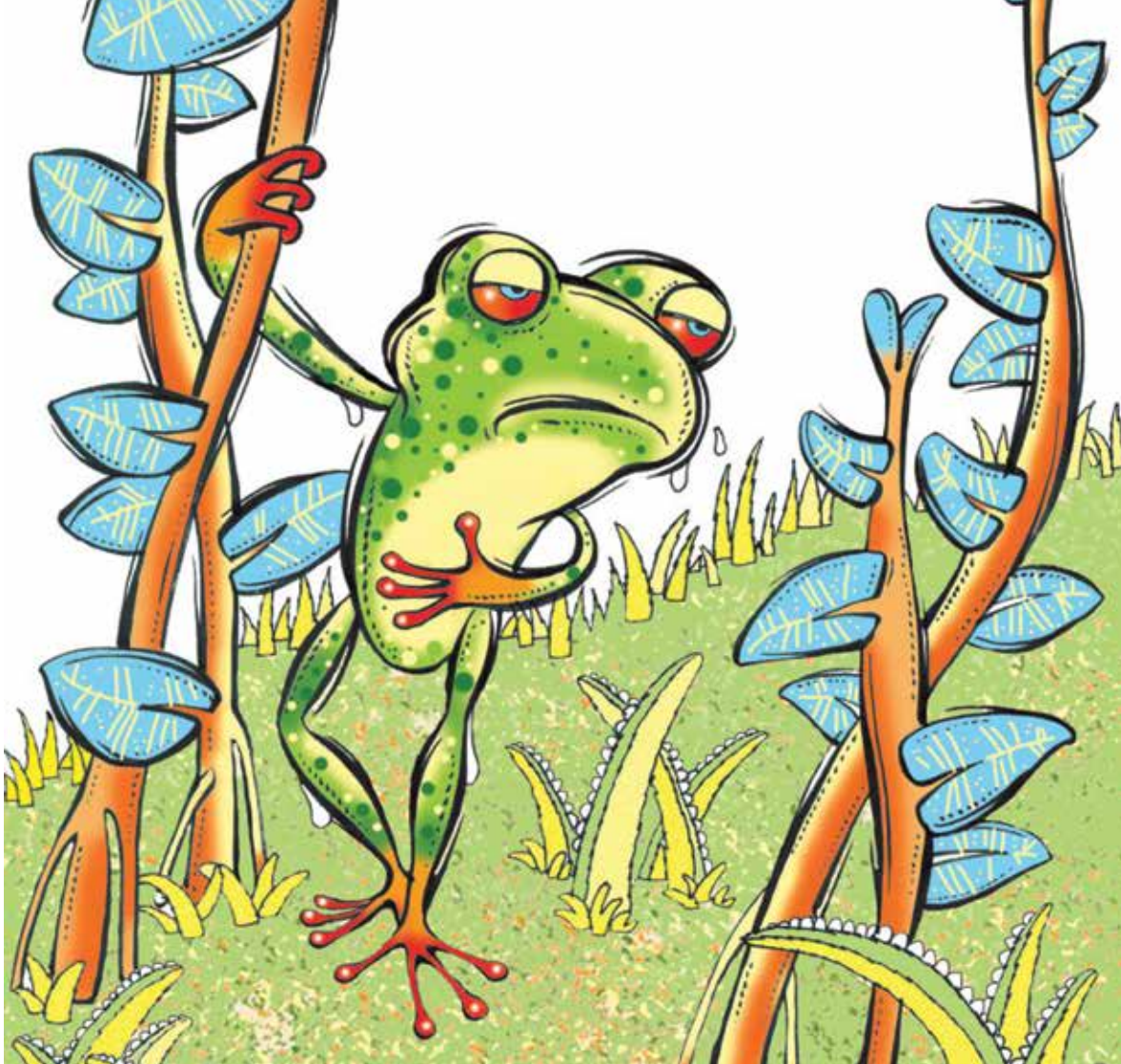
Frog jumped again.

He could not catch any today!



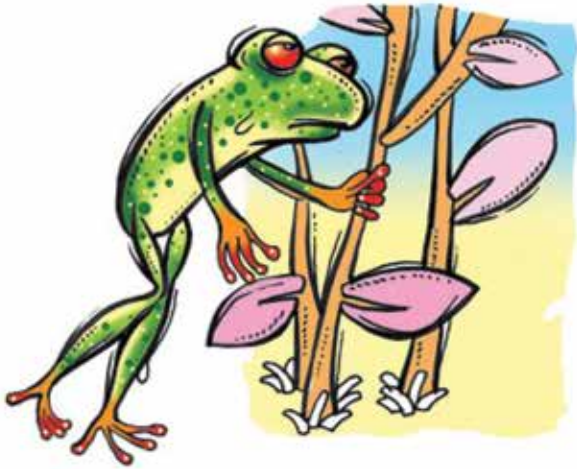


After all that jumping, he was even more hungry.



His stomach hurt.

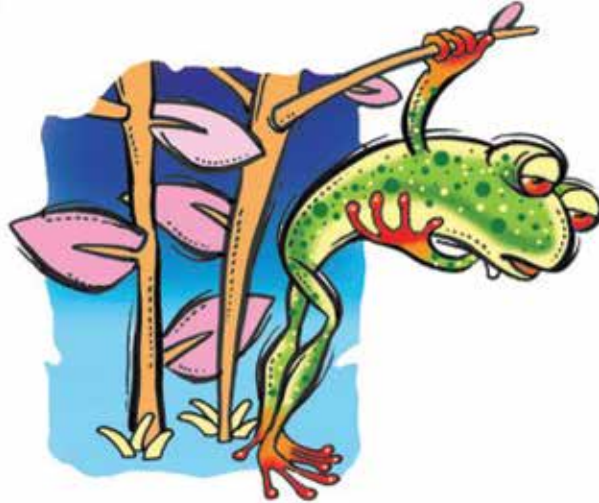




“The bugs are fast!” he said.

Then he saw a light shining far away.

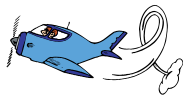


“What is that light?” he asked.

Frog ate until he was full.

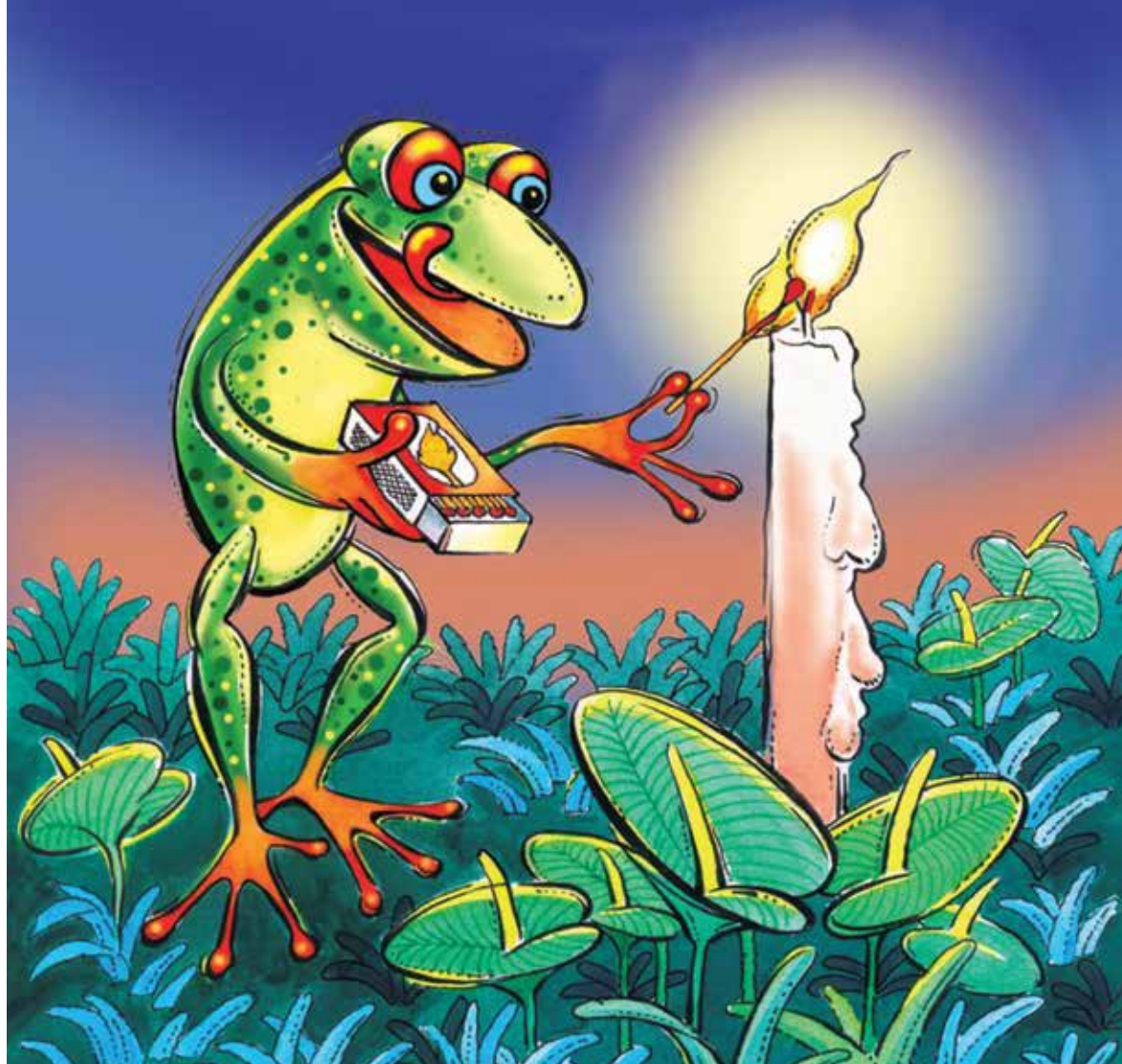


The next day, Frog got a candle. "This is how
