JOB GOAL:

To provide an educational atmosphere in which students will move toward the fulfillment of their potential for intellectual, emotional, physical, and psychological growth and maturation in accordance with District philosophy, goals, and objectives.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES: * Essential Performance Responsibilities

- * 1. Plan and effectively implement instructional activities designed to achieve goals and objectives of the curriculum.
- * 2. Provide a safe, nurturing environment that stimulates academic, moral, and social growth.
- 3. Meet with and instruct assigned classes in the locations and at the times designated.
- * 4. Communicate clearly and effectively in both written and oral form with students, parents, and others.
- 5. Take all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials, and facilities.
- * 6. Check equipment and apparatus prior to use to ensure safety and proper working condition.
- * 7. Use knowledge of individual student's physical condition in planning and implementing appropriate physical activities.
- * 8. Evaluate student progress on a regular basis to include academic, physical, and social growth of students.
- * 9. Maintain accurate, complete, and correct records and inventories as required by law, District policy, and administrative regulations.
- * 10. Assist in enforcement of school rules, administrative regulations, and Board policy.
- 11. Implement a variety of instructional techniques to meet varying learning styles of students.
- * 12. Assist students in learning to accept responsibility, demonstrate respect for people and property, and demonstrate self-discipline.
- * 13. Adjust instructional activities for students with disabilities as needed.
- * 14. Provide appropriate supervision for teacher-aide when such an aide is provided.
 - 15. Perform such other duties as the principal or supervisor may assign.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

The physical requirements described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of the job.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to sit; use hands to manipulate objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms; and talk and hear.
